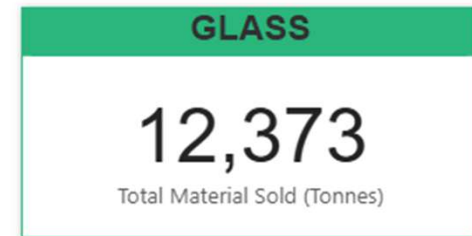

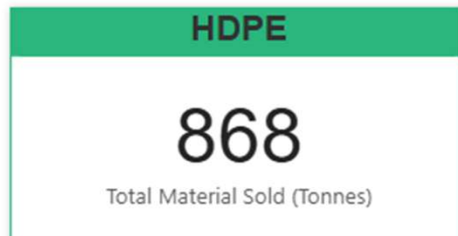
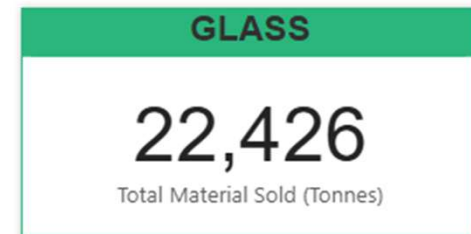
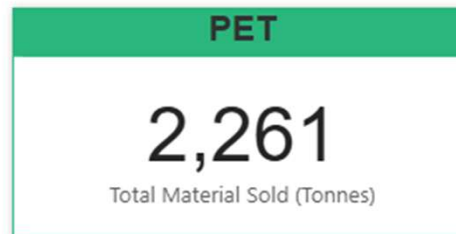
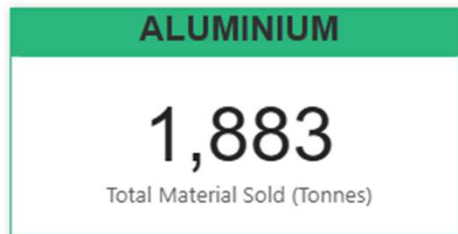
Total weight of material types collected and delivered for recycling under the CDS, listed by material types and redeemed through MRFs (excluding refund points)
